

Having notched over 20 years of experience in the golfing industry, and that has given him the confidence to build teams in the course he is managing to effectively carry out the necessary tests and abide by the quidelines.

Don graduated in 2003 immediately started work at a course named Waters Edge in his home country Sri Lanka. A team of local graduates, worked tirelessly with the information and technology at hand to build a 18 hole golf course. This sparked his passion for the field he worked in. And decided to pursue higher studies in Turf Management from Ohio State University and interned with a top 100 course there while studying.

Since then he has been in Jumeirah Golf Estate, Tiger Woods golf course in Dubai. Worked in different countries gaining valuable experience. USA, Thailand, Singapore Malaysia, Doha, Karachi...and now in Bangalore.

Don, has been with our club since January 2024 and his tenure is for 2 years. There is a visible and marked difference in the way our course is playing. His unique approach to the course that he manages makes him a valuable member of our faculty. His passion is obvious as he loves what he does.

He says he observed for a few weeks before he started changing a few things around, He finds BGC unique because in his opinion its one of the smallest 18 holes golf course in the world at 58 acres. Its also the most shaded course he has worked in with over 2700 trees. Shade management has proven to be beneficial. And improves the quality of the course. His desire is to see our golf course dial up a notch in terms of play, infrastructure and preservation.

His approach as a leader is to be kind but firm. He has 40 people working in his team, and his preference is to train the youth who have a better understanding of technology and gadgets and who can hopefully stay, refine and hone their skills, and run the course in the years to come.

A teetotaller, a non-smoker, with a preference for vegetarian food.

A practicing Buddhist, a good samaritan. He comes from a humble background and gives back to society in many ways. He is someone who has financially aided over 1000 young students through a charity organisation set up with a group of his friends called Sasnaka Sansada.

He hopes there will be more opportunities in universities to study sports, turf science and other streams here in Asia.

Don feels being married to his job is the reason he's currently single. He is a keen photographer, and says he has good oratorial skills. He said while he is in India, visiting places like Kashmir, Mysore, Chikmagalur, and surrounding places are on his to-do list. Currently he spends his weekends with the Srilankans living in Bangalore and gets his fix of home food. He thinks of himself as a social butterfly and enjoys meeting new people.

He values time and would like go back to his home country after his retirement and spend quality time with his family.
