Stores operations have been optimized including shifting the liquor store to the NCH. We have also established a full fledged general main store for the whole club, which will be managed by qualified and trained personnel. We are looking out for a purchase manager who will use the transparent reverse auction site "easy source". With this we will be streamlining purchases for all departments and will now come under the direct scanner of the Treasurer.

Meeting a long pending request from members, a separate Bridge Room has been established at the OCH.

We are seriously working on doubling our present car park of 125 cars in the NCH. This facility will adjoin the New Club house and will have two floors. One below the ground and another above it. The basement floor will have a provision to further increase number of parking bays by using mechanical lifts, should the need arise. This project will be brought to the SGM for your approval after the final plans and costing is ready.

The month of November has been a month of team building, team practice matches and the BGL 5.0 games kicked in soon after the inaugural ceremony of 16th November. We are in the midst of the action now.

We have a fantastic prize for the winners this year. The winning team goes for an all expenses paid trip to Cape Town in South Africa, enjoying the vibrant and stunning city views. two rounds of golf at Royal Cape Golf, Africas Oldest Champion Golf Club!
