Explanation: BGC being in the centre of town provides a unique issue of housing for the caddies. They have to travel from outskirts to reach the course, to ensure caddies can maintain a basic standard of living, a reasonable adjustment in fees is both fair and necessary. Further there is a decrease in the number of caddies at our course, this increase may motivate them so that we have increased numbers. Adjusting fees aligns the club with prevailing market rates, ensuring fairness, no increase has been done for the last 8 years.

Mr. Narayan Menon (M - 255) Resolution

RESOLVED that the SGM approve the setting up of a Committee of five members of the Club with the required experience, to look into the improvements required in the management and organization structure of the Club at all levels, including the Management Committee Level and the Operational Level and make recommendations for improvement.

RESOLVED further that this Committee be authorized to hire such professional help as required to conduct the exercise.

Explanation

Ever since I can remember (2005), the Governance & Management Structure of the Club has remained the same, a Captain, an Hon. Secretary, an Hon. Treasurer and five Committee Members, supported by an Administrator and an organization structure below them.

The Club has grown significantly over the last twenty years in terms of membership (approx. 4,600 members today), of activities, of facilities financial and other assets, information technologies required, increased government public policy issues and compliance requirements for GST and other matters. Furthermore, the club has been facing an increased number of legal issues

It is clear that the same static Governance & Management Structure installed some 20 to 30 years ago cannot deal with requirements of today effectively. It is obvious, that the Captain, Hon. Secretary (in particular) and the Hon. Treasurer are grossly overburdened.

The organization structure below them does not have the qualifications, the bandwidth and the experience and the ability to perform the tasks they are required to do, with exceptions. Therefore, there is an overwhelming concentration of tasks at the office bearer level, which is required to attend to immediate operational needs and matters with various Government agencies and the Registrar of

	Societies, which does not leave time for in depth policy discussions and long term planning Accordingly, it is clear that steps need to be initiated to address the above. Hence this resolution is submitted for your kind consideration
